Uniform Policy – June 2010

The Board of Trustees of St. Canice's School believes that a school uniform reinforces a child's sense of pride and responsibility in the school, as well as avoiding peer pressure and competition between students. In order to maintain a high standard of dress children will therefore be required to adhere to the uniform schedule, as attached.

Uniform Procedure

Enrolment: On application to enrol, the parent/guardian agrees that the child meets the uniform standard set by the Board of Trustees. The full uniform is specified in the Schedule; all items are to be named, worn correctly when attending school, travelling to and from school, and when representing the school at functions or sporting events.

Emergencies: A pupil must provide a note written by a parent or guardian explaining why a temporary exemption is necessary.

Non-compliance:

1. If there is no explanation provided by the parent or guardian, immediate action may be taken. This will be at the discretion of the Principal.

2. If any parent or guardian does not provide a written explanation within three days, the Principal will notify the Chairman of the Board of Trustees and a Board member will contact the parent.

3. If there is no satisfactory explanation, the Board of Trustees and the Principal will decide what further action should be taken.

Special cases: Any request for a variation to the uniform must be put to the Principal in writing and, if agreed to, an exemption will be granted. Any exceptions on medical grounds must be accompanied by a Doctors Certificate.

Accessories: Only watches and plain ear studs or small plain sleepers are allowed. No other jewellery, adornment or other items of clothing are to be worn with school uniform.

Make up: No make up is to be worn by school children wearing school uniform.
